1. SCHEDULE OF RACE

2. HANDICAPPING

2.1 The handicap will be a Time Correction Factor (TCF) which is applied to a boats elapsed time at the finish of each race.

3. DIVISIONS

- 3.1 There will be 2 Divisions.
- 3.2 Competitors will be advised of the division into which they have been allocated into via email and/or text message by no later than 2 hours before the race.

5. COURSES & MARKS

5.1 <u>DIVISION 1</u>

FULL COURSE: Start - GI - FD - EC - SI - CI - FD - GI - Finish

SHORT COURSE: Start - GI - FD - CI - FD - GI - Finish

5.2 <u>DIVISION 2</u>

FULL COURSE: Start - GI - FD - CI - FD - GI - Finish

SHORT COURSE: Start - GI - FD - GI - Finish

- 5.3 All marks are to be passed to Starboard unless the mark is suffixed (P), which indicates the mark is to be passed to Port.
- 5.4 There will be no laid marks.

6. THE START

- The start line will be the transit line defined by triangular leading marks on the BSC's clubhouse deck and building. The line extends from outside the line of moored boats to Cockatoo Island.
- 6.2 Races will be started as follows. This changes RRS rule 26.

Signal	
Warning	Long sound 5 minutes before the start
Preparatory	Short sound signal 4 minutes before the start
One minute	Short sound signal 1 minute before the start
Start	Long sound signal made at the start

6.3 The Starting Signal will be the Warning Signal for the next Division scheduled to start.

7. TIME LIMIT

7.1 The time limit will be 1700 hours.
