#### A2. HANDICAPPING

A2.1 This is a pursuit race series. Handicaps will determine the start time for each boat. Handicaps are subject to adjustment after each race has been finalised.

#### A3. SERIES SCORING

A3.1 A boat shall discard her highest score after 4 races, her next highest score after 6 races and her next highest score after 8 races. There will be a maximum of 3 discards in each series.

## A4. DIVISIONS

A4.1 There will be 1 Division.

# A5. START TIMES

- A5.1 There will be no Starting Signals. The changes RRS 26.
- A5.2 The start time will be 1430hrs Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)
- A5.3 The list of competitors indicating each boat's scheduled starting time and the course to be sailed will be posted on the relevant series *results* page on the BSCs website, no later than 1 hour before the start of the event.

## A6. COURSES & MARKS

- A6.1 Course 1: Start Sn SI CI GI CI Sn SI CI Finish
- A6.2 Short Course 1: Start Sn SI CI GI Finish
- A6.3 Course 2: Start GI(P) CI(P) SI(P) SI(P) CI(P) SI(P) SI(P) Finish
- A6.4 Short Course 2: Start GI(P) CI(P) SI(P) Sn(P) Finish
- A6.5 Course 3: Start CI(P) Sn SI CI(P) Sn SI CI(P) Sn SI Finish
- A6.6 Course 4: Start SI(P) Sn(P) CI SI(P) Sn(P) CI SI(P) Sn(P) CI Finish
- A6.7 All marks are to be passed to Starboard unless the mark is suffixed (P), which indicates the mark is to be passed to Port.

- A6.8 Courses will be communicated to competitors via text message prior to 1.50pm and/or announced on VHF Ch.73 on the day of the race.
- A6.9 There will be no laid marks.
