B2. HANDICAPPING

B2.1 This is a pursuit race series. Handicaps will apply at the start and will determine the start time for each boat. Handicaps are subject to adjustment after each race has been finalised.

B3. SERIES SCORING

B3.2 A boat shall discard her highest score after 4 races, her 2nd highest score after 7 races, her 3rd after 10 races, her 4th after 15 races and her 5th after 19 races. There will be a maximum of 3 discards in each. There will a maximum of 5 discards in the overall Series.

B4. DIVISIONS

B4.1 The number of divisions will be determined by the RC.

B5. START TIMES

B5.1 There will be no Starting Signals. The changes RRS 26.

B5.2 The start time will be 1430hrs Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)

B5.3 The list of competitors indicating each boat's starting time and the course to be sailed will be posted on the relevant series results page of the BSC's website, no later than 1 hour before the start of the event.

A6. COURSES & MARKS

A6.1 Course 1: Start – Sn – SI - CI - GI – CI - Sn - SI – CI – Finish

A6.2 Short Course 1: Start – Sn – SI - CI – GI – Finish

A6.3 Course 2: Start – GI(P) – CI(P) – SI(P) – Sn(P) – CI(P) – SI(P) – Sn(P) – Finish

A6.4 Short Course 2: Start – GI(P) – CI(P) – SI(P) – Sn(P) – Finish

A6.5 Course 3: Start – CI(P) – Sn – SI – CI(P) – Sn – SI – CI(P) – Sn – SI - Finish

A6.6 Course 4: Start – SI(P) – Sn(P) – CI – SI(P) – Sn(P) – CI – SI(P) – Sn(P) – CI - Finish

A6.7 All marks are to be passed to Starboard unless the mark is suffixed (P), which indicates the mark is to be passed to Port.

A6.8 Courses will be communicated to competitors via mobile telephone message prior to 2pm and/or announced on VHF Ch.73 on the day of the race.

A6.9 There will be no laid marks.
