A3.2 VHF Ch.73 will also used if the Race is being managed by Starters, for changes and updates during the race.

A4 Start Times, Warning Signals and Divisions

A4.1 There will be no Starting Signals . This changes RRS 26

A4.2 The list of competitors and start times will be published on BSC website , no later than 1 hour before race start

A4.3 This is a pursuit race series. Handicaps will determine the start time for each boat.

A5.4 All marks are passed to Starboard unless mark is suffixed(P) which indicates the mark is to be passed to Port

A5.5 Courses will be communicated to competitors via WhatsApp "BSC Friday Afternoon Series" prior to race start

A5.6 VHF Ch.73 will be used during the Race for changes i.e Shortened Course

A5.7 The Start/Finish line will be deemed a Gate. Times recorded at the Start/Finish may be used as Finish times

A6 The Start

A6.1 The start line will be the transit line defined by triangular leading marks on the clubhouse deck and building.

A6.2 The line extends from outside the line of moored boats to Cockatoo Island

A6.3 Boats shall avoid the starting area until her scheduled start time.

A6.4 (NP)The RC may disqualify any boat not complying with SI 8.1. This changes RRS 63.1.

A7 The Finish

A7.1 If a race official is not available to record finishing and first lap times, entrants will be advised prior to the race start to record their own times and post to the WhatsApp Group "BSC Friday Afternoon Series". This changes RRS 26

A7.2 The finishing line will be between the transit line defined by the triangular leading marks on the BSC clubhouse deck and building. The line extends from outside the line of moored boats to Cockatoo Island.

A7.3 Boats are reminded of their obligation under RRS 23 and once finished, to keep clear of boats that are still racing and so as not to obstruct the race officials view of the finish line and the BSC's Clubhouse Finish Line.

A11 Equipment

- A11.1 This is a Non-Spinnaker Series . Headsails may be poled out but must be tacked to the foot of the forestay and fully hanked or attached to the forestay by a luff groove device.
- A11.2 Hiking Aids, including trapezes and leg straps shall not be permitted to be used to assist crew members to hike outside of the gunnels of any boat unless these aids are permitted by the Class Rules for that keelboat or dinghy.
This changes RRS 49.1
- A11.3 The use of powered winches on boats which compete in BSC events is permitted. This changes RRS 52
