## MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION AND DECISION:

 The Club has received a fees invoice from Sailing Australia for \$12,075, it was resolved that CR would write to Sailing Australia advising that the Club had recently expended funds on urgent deck repairs and installed a new pontoon for dingy sailors and that Sailing Australia substantially reduce the annual fees payable by the Club for the next two years.

### Club Managers Report:

- Currently we have 120 paid up members. Further email/reminderwill be sent out...
- Membership and storage income is roughly 12% lower than for the same period last year. I
  don't view this as being an issue other than members being slow to pay.
- Bar sales are roughly 10% higher than for the same period last year. Food sales are 25% higher than for the same period last year. Hall hire income is up roughly 7.5% more than for the same period last year (fees have increased by 10%).

# **INFRASTRUCTURE:**

Materials have been ordered to complete the deck repairs.

## **SAILING SCHOOL:**

- Income is 48% lower than for the same period last year. This is in part due when we reconciled payments last year versus this year. Also, unlike last year there haven't been any chartering of the Magic 25's. There is interest from members moving forward.
- Courses and classes are now ready to go and we can now do dinghy and powerboat courses.

#### **REGATTA:**

- A preliminary meeting was called for volunteers.
- It was well attended, and I will arrange a follow up meeting soon.
- Meanwhile, Cobden & Hayson are onboard once again and we have successfully raised the sponsorship contribution from \$5k to \$6k.
- The Pubs Race will now be held on the Sunday of the Regatta Weekend.

# **RISK MANAGEMENT WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY (WHS):**

- An Incident Management Plan, that all members should be familiar with is to be kept in the clubhouse. In addition, the race starters are to keep a permanent copy at the starting desk
- The Committee agreed that in circumstances where the wind on the harbour side is/or isanticipated to exceed 20 knots per hour, no sailing school course must be undertaken.
- With the temporary removal of some decking, all members must not enter any clearly marked works areas on the deck.
- All members are to become familiar with the WHS document. A copy has been placed on the website and all members are strongly encouraged to read it and adhere to it.
- The current WHS document will be reviewed an up-dated over the next few months.
