Case Introduction: Room at a continuing obstruction.

Procedural Matters:

- Jury member John Blair raced in the race, placing 4th he was a casual entry and so
 would have no placing in the series result.
- Jury member Simon Oliver raced in the race, however was scored OCS.
- Both conflicts were declared at the start of the hearing and both parties consented to their being members of the protest committee (RRS 63.4(b)(1)).

Facts found:

- 1. Winds were approximately 8-10 knots and from the east.
- 2. Spectacle Island was a mark of the course, to be passed to port.
- 3. Krakatini and Airspeed reaching towards the north-western point of Spectacle Island, both on starboard. Airspeed to windward and just clear astern of Krakatini and travelling faster and closer to the island.
- 4. Krakatini hardened up to pass close to the point of the island, creating an overlap with Airspeed.
- 5. When the overlap was established, there was approximately 1 boat length between the point and Krakatini, with Airspeed between Krakatini and the point.
- 6. Krakatini continued to sail close the point and needed to bear away to give Airspeed room to pass the point.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. Spectacle Island as a mark of the course is also a continuing obstruction.
- 2. When Airspeed became overlapped with Krakatini, there was room between the point and Krakatini for Airspeed to pass between them (RRS 19.2(c)).

No rules broken.
